

A Voice Built *In the Crossing*

Enoch Osei speaks from inside the story — of migration, identity, institutional belonging, and what it takes to build a career, and a self, that holds its shape across borders and systems not built with you in mind. An organisational psychologist by training and a memoirist by discipline, he leaves audiences not merely inspired but oriented: with language for what they are living through and a clearer sense of what to do on Monday.
